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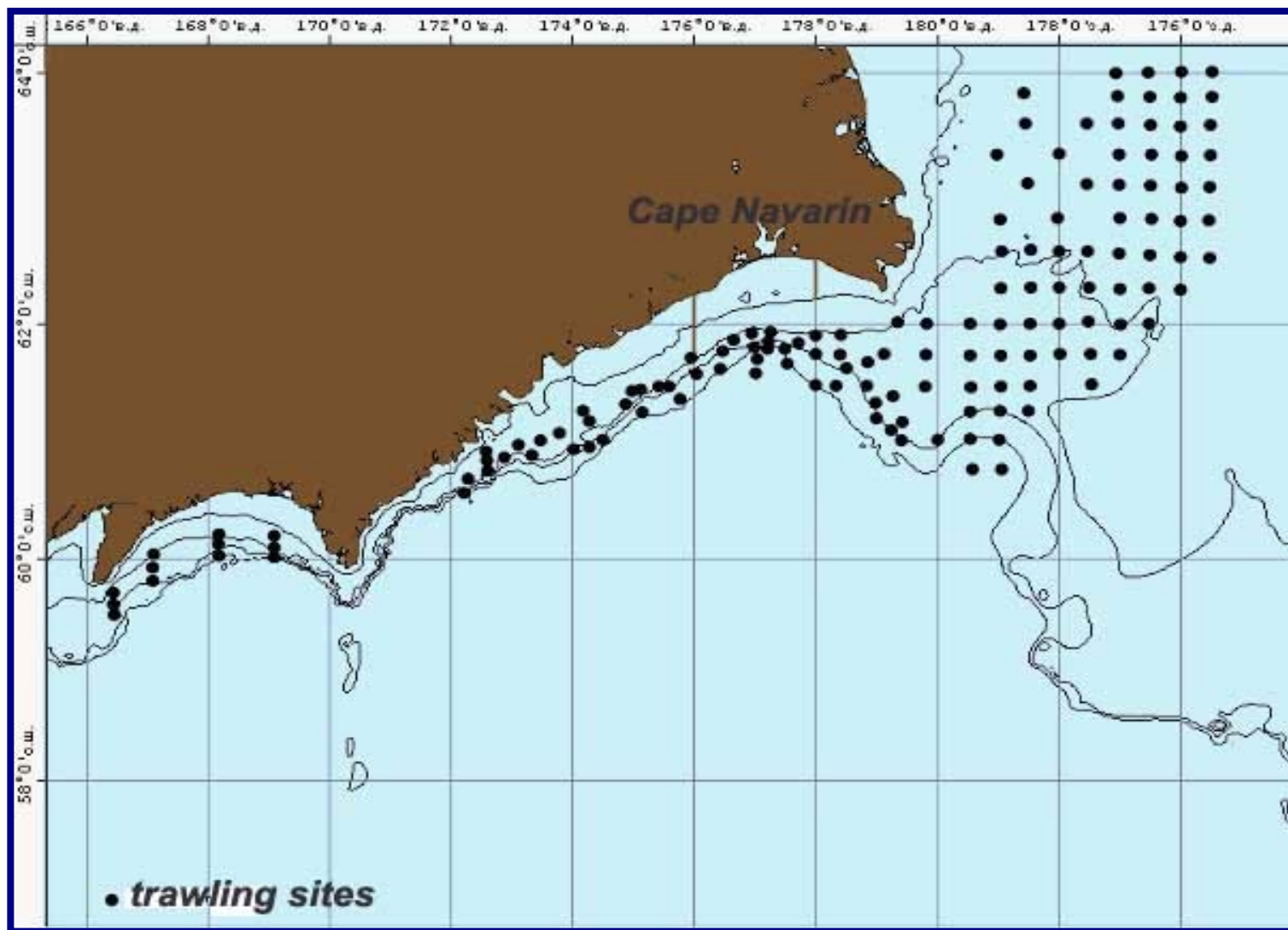

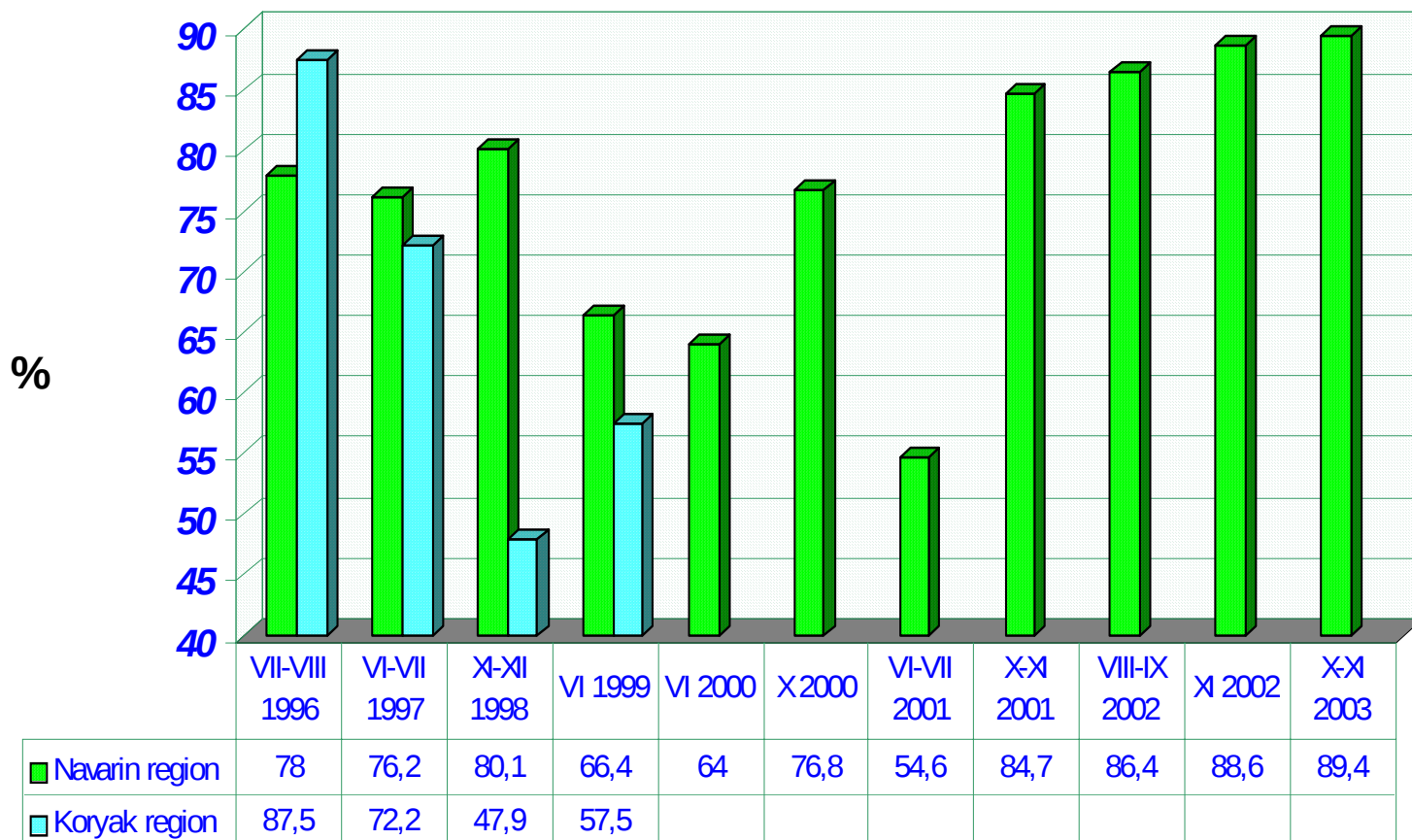

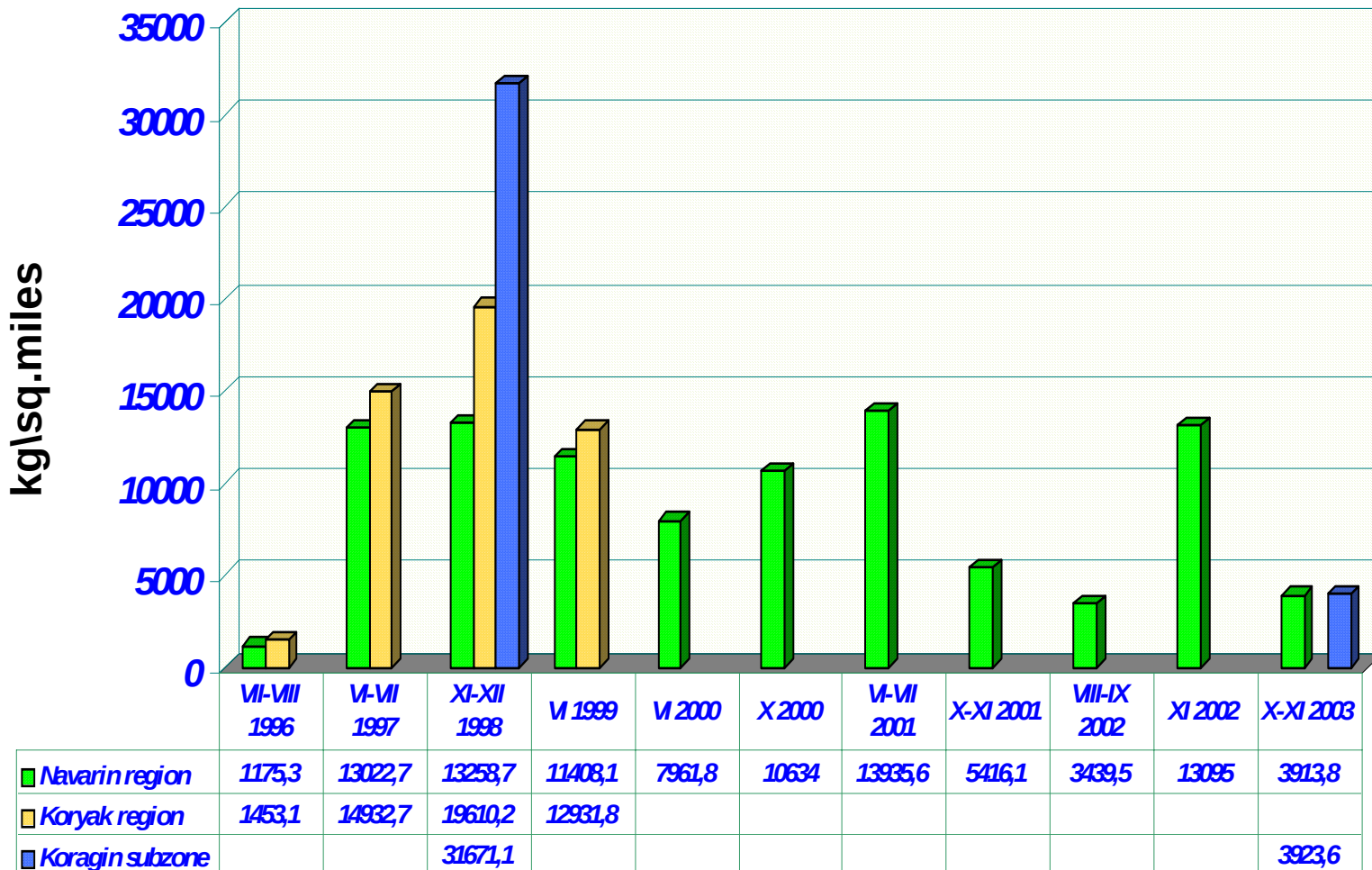
Standard scheme of the bottom trawl survey in the North and West Bering Sea



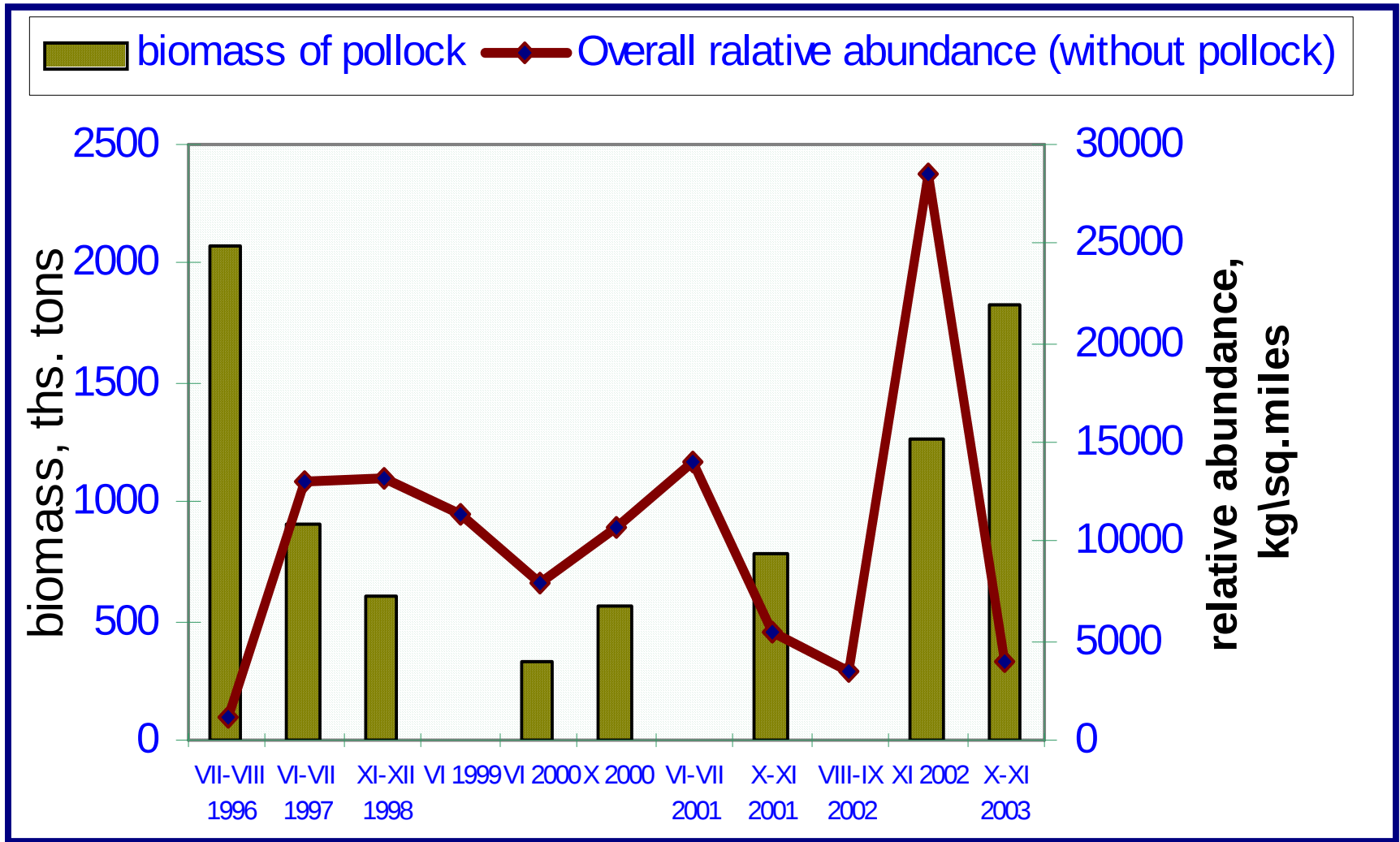
Share of pollock biomass in catches based on bottom trawl survey data (by region, month and year)

in the North and North-West Bering Sea (without pollock)

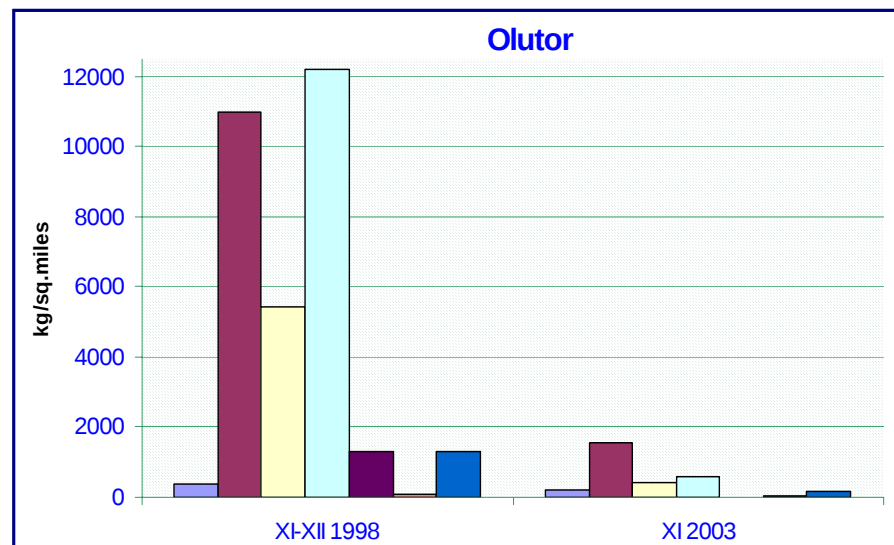
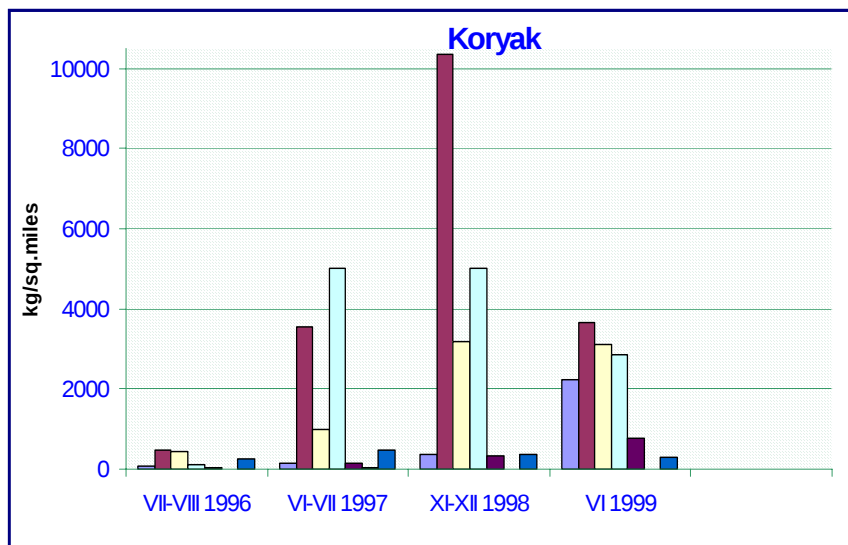
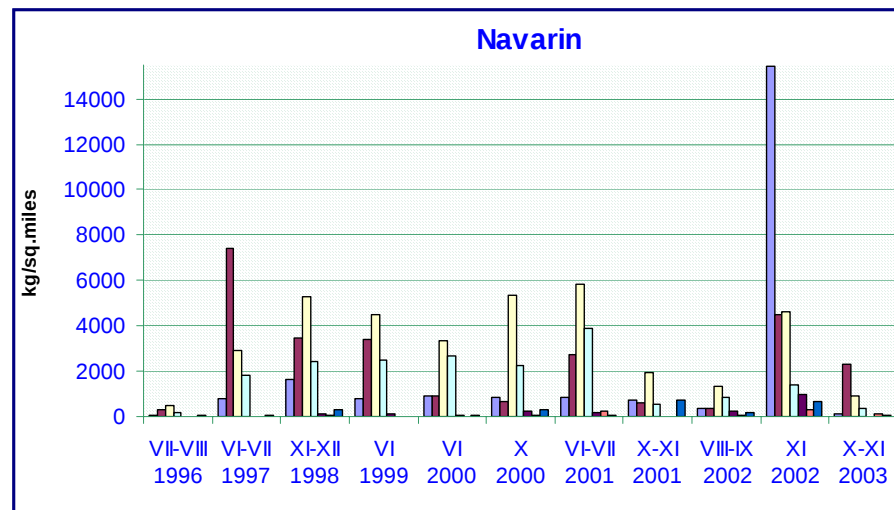


Pollock biomass, and overall density of fish distribution (without pollock) in Navarin region (Bering Sea)

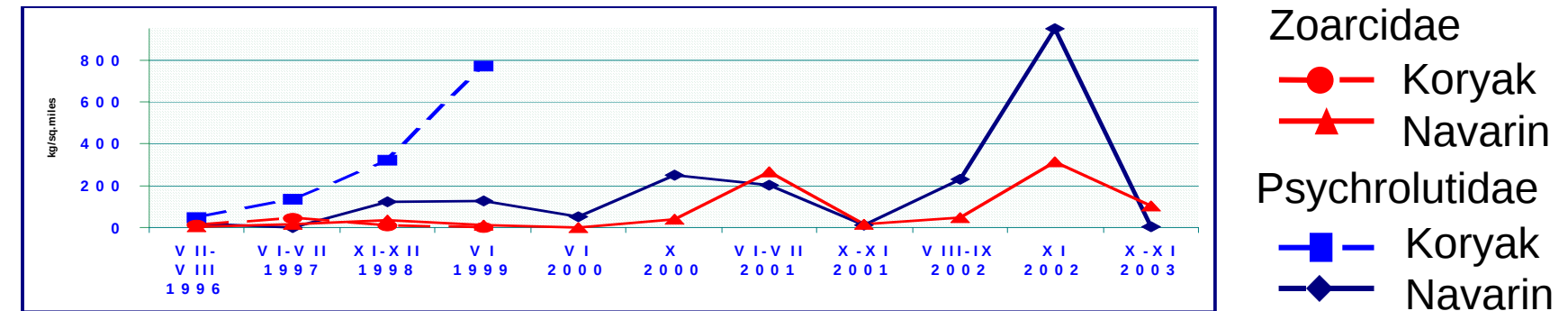
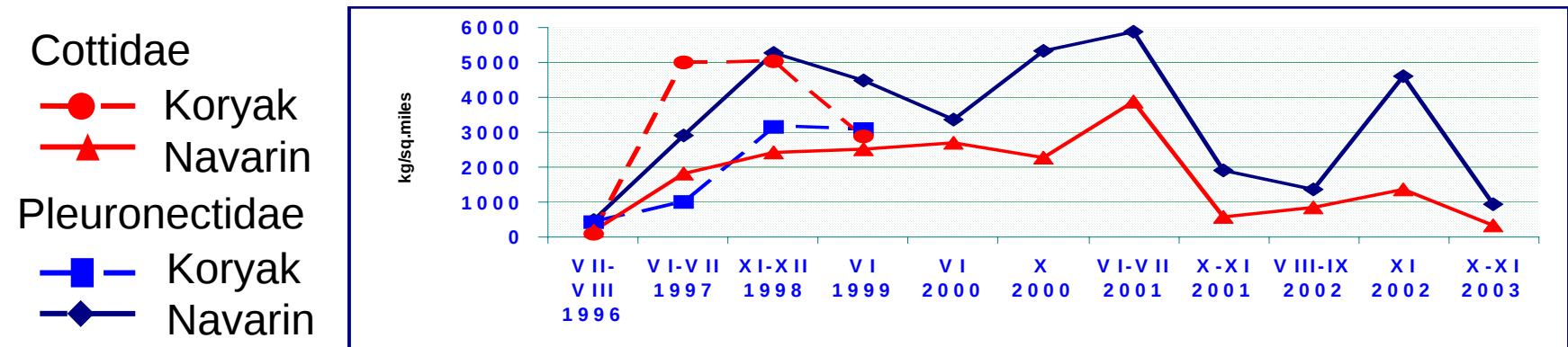
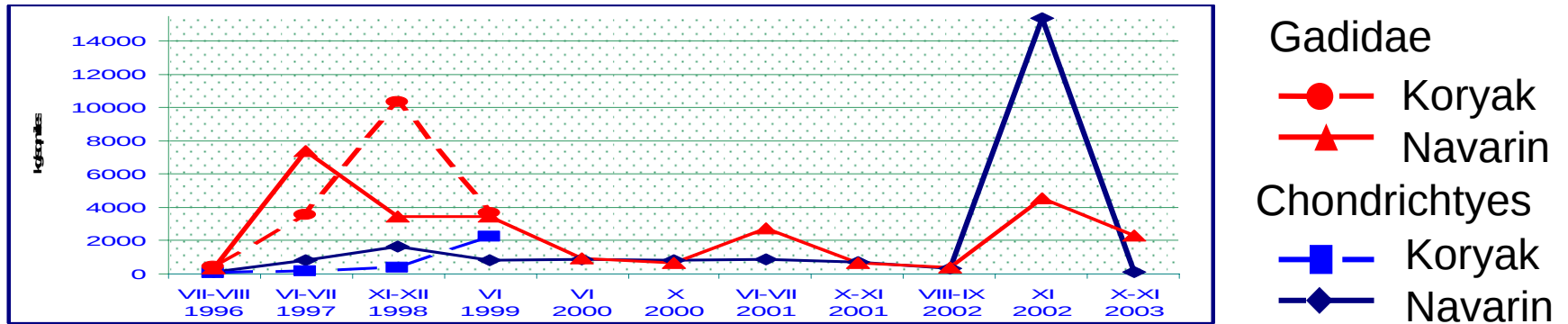


Relative abundance of demersal fishes in the North and North-West Bering Sea (by taxa)

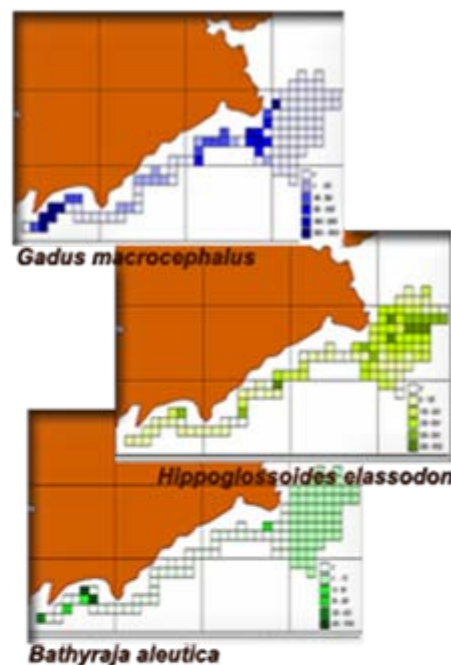
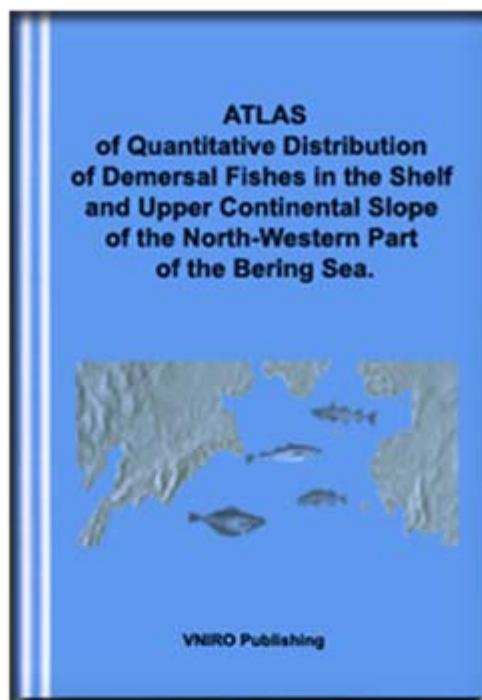
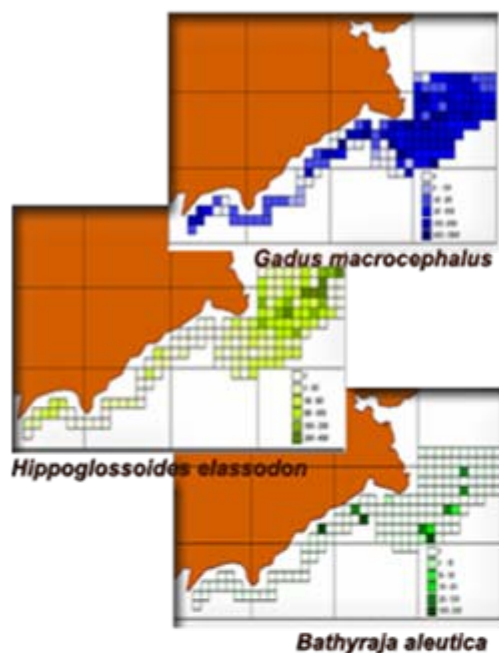

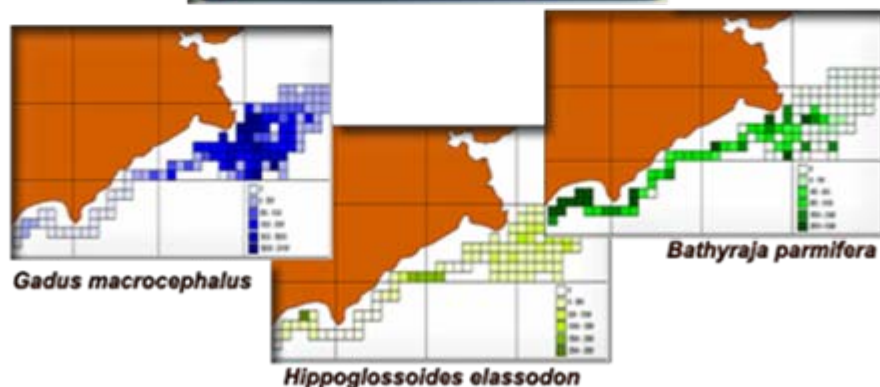
Relative abundance of the main taxa of demersal fishes in Navarin and Koryak regions (by year)
