- □ Dr. Mark L Wells is a Professor of Oceanography (Emeritus) at the School of Marine Sciences, University of Maine. He specializes in nutritional trace metal interactions with phytoplankton, carbon biogeochemistry and Harmful Algal Blooms (HABs).
- ☐ He got his Undergraduate Degree and Master Degree from the University of British Columbia, and his PhD at the University of Maine.
- □ He was a Postdoctoral Scholar at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography, and held a position at the University of California, Santa Cruz, working on iron biogeochemistry. He moved back to the University of Maine in 1998 where he expanded his research base to contribute to many other areas of oceanographic research.
- □ He is the co-Chair of the Section of Harmful Algal Blooms of the North Pacific Marine Science Organization (PICES), and is the PICES representative on the IOC-UNESCO Intergovernmental Panel on Harmful Algal Blooms (IPHAB).
